Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in the Institution

“Ragging” means

Any conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any other student, indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance hardship or psychological hard or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student or asking the students to do any act or perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student.

“Any act physical and mental abuse (including bulling and exclusion) targeted at another student (fresher or otherwise) on the ground of colour, race, religion, caste, ethnicity, gender, (including transgender), sexual orientation, appearance, nationality, regional origins, linguistic, identity, place of birth, place of residence or economic background.”

In pursuance to the judgment of the Hon’ble Supreme Court of India and in compliance of the UGC and AICTE Regulations 2009:

1. University Grants Commission–'Regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009' under No.F.1-16/ 2007 (CPP-II) dated 17th June, 2009.
2. All India Council for Technical Education – Notification No. F.No.37-3/Legal/AICTE/2009 dated 01.07.2009 on 'Prevention and prohibition of Ragging in Technical Institutions, Universities including Deemed to be Universities imparting technical education'.

Ragging in all its forms is totally banned in the entire institution, within the campus or outside and as per the provisions of the Act of the Central Government and the State Government, strict action shall be taken against those found guilty of ragging and / or of abetting ragging.

Ragging is a cognizable offence under the law and prohibited in all its forms.

“Punishment”

Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Anti-Ragging Committee of the institution, the possible punishment for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following:

- ❖ Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges
- ❖ Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits
- ❖ Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process
- ❖ Withholding results
- ❖ Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- ❖ Suspension/expulsion from the hostel
- ❖ Cancellation of admission
- ❖ Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters
- ❖ Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specific period
- ❖ Fine ranging between Rupees 1,000/- to Rupees 10,000/-
- ❖ Collective punishment: When the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment

Therefore, all the students of HNCC are advised to make it a Ragging Free Campus.

“Functions of Anti-ragging Squad Committee”

- ❖ To prohibit, prevent and eliminate the courage of ragging including any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student, or indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student or asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or tormentor embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student, with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student, in all higher education institutions in the country, and thereby, to provide for the healthy development, physically and psychologically, of all students, the All India Council for Technical Education, (AICTE) brings forth these Regulations.

- ❖ Institution shall also constitute a smaller body to be known as the Anti-Ragging Squad to be nominated by the Head of the Institution with such representation as may be considered necessary for maintaining vigil, oversight and patrolling functions and shall remain mobile, alert and active at all times, provided that the Anti-Ragging Squad shall have representation of various members of the campus community and shall have no outside representation.

- ❖ It shall be the duty of the Anti-Ragging Squad to be called upon to make surprise raids on hostels, and other places vulnerable to incidents and having the potential for ragging and shall be empowered to inspect such places.
- ❖ It shall also be the duty of the Anti-Ragging Squad to conduct an on-the-spot enquiry into any incidents of ragging referred to it by the Head of the institution or any member of the faculty or any member of the staff or any student or any parent or guardian or any employee of a service provider or by any other person, as the case may be, and the enquiry report along with recommendations shall be submitted to the Anti-Ragging Committee for action
- ❖ Provided that the Anti-Ragging Squad shall conduct such enquiry observing a fair and transparent procedure and the principles of natural justice and after giving adequate opportunity to the student or students accused of ragging and other witnesses to place before it the facts, documents and views concerning the incidents of ragging, and considerations such other relevant information as may be required
